

History

In 2012, the Washington, DC-based nonprofit CINE launched an innovative film scoring contest for student and amateur composers from around the world. The contest was announced at CINE's 2012 awards gala by renowned composer and CINE Legends Award recipient Marvin Hamlisch. In 2014, the contest was renamed in his honor as the Marvin Hamlisch Film Scoring Contest for Emerging Composers.

The contest continued to grow, adding a category for youth composers and hosting receptions each fall in New York to honor the winners of the Marvin Hamlisch Award, presented annually by Terre Blair Hamlisch.

Within six years, worldwide participation increased by over 450%, and in 2018, over 700 composers from 65 countries participated, making the contest a truly global celebration of the universal language of music.





The Marvin Hamlisch Awards

In 2019, the Marvin Hamlisch International Music Awards was created to house the contest and expand its impact, creating opportunities for emerging composers in the fields of film/media scoring, musical theatre, classical music and jazz.

The Marvin Hamlisch International Music Awards will be formally introduced at a presentation and concert, in collaboration with Queens College, City University of New York, on Monday, November 18, 2019, where the 2018 Marvin Hamlisch Award recipients will be honored and the new categories formally unveiled.

The 2019 Marvin Hamlisch International Music Awards will begin accepting registrations in late 2019, and announce its nominees and recipients by the fall of 2020.


